Professor Dr. Hanaa Khair El-Din

Prof. Dr. Hanaa Khair El-Din is a distinguished professor of Economics at the Faculty of Economics and Political Science, Cairo University. She is recognized as one of the leading economists in Egypt and the Arab world, particularly in the fields of microeconomics, mathematical economics, and econometrics. She obtained her Ph.D. in Economics from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) in the United States. Her research areas include international trade, macroeconomic models, industrial development, project evaluation, poverty, and social issues.

Prof. Dr. Khair El-Din has authored numerous economic works on microeconomic theory, mathematical economics, and reports addressing poverty and low-income crises. Her solo and collaborative writings on the fundamentals of economics, microeconomic theory, and mathematical and econometric economics have established a significant foundation for educating and introducing generations of Egyptian and Arab economists to the principles of the discipline. Her scientific contributions have informed and enlightened those interested in the developments, opportunities, and challenges of economics in various fields, including economic policy evaluation, trade, inflation, growth, and income distribution. She has published many research papers in specialized scientific journals both within Egypt and internationally and has supervised numerous master's theses and doctoral dissertations in specialized economic topics.

Throughout her career, Dr. Khair El-Din has held numerous prestigious positions. She has been a professor of economics at Cairo University since 1978, served as Head of the Economics Department at the same faculty from 1990 to 1996, and managed the Center for Economic and Financial Studies and Research from 1985 to 1990. She was also the Executive Director and Head of Research at the Egyptian Center for Economic Studies from 2006 to 2010. Additionally, she served as a member of the United Nations University Council in Tokyo and chaired the Subcommittee on International Economics at the Academy of Scientific Research. She was also a member of the Shura Council and various national specialized councils and economic committees, including the Subcommittee on International Economics at the Academy of Scientific Research.

Dr. Hanaa Khair El-Din is remembered for her simplicity and calm demeanor throughout her life. She was distinguished and beloved in her fields of expertise and had many admirers and students.
